SCOPE OF THE WORK

1. Original Peter Fox Report. The work package was originally put together in a report by Peter Fo	ox in
Feb 2013 and included:	

- a. Middle Hill: A
 - Soakaway on the North side in the Westacre, Waverley Area
 - Soakaway on the south side between Hartrow and Neathem/Amberly
- b. Work on the Bickleigh Access B
- a. Lower Hill. Soakaways on the south side C
 - Pellinore to Folly Cottage
 - Hollygate to St Marys
- d. By Airlie Road, changing the kerb/gully D
- e. CAT Scan and Trial Holes E
- **2. June 2013 Sub Committee Meeting**. Following a meeting with Paul Barlow, Peter Fox and myself the following way ahead was agreed and proposed to the Ctee:
 - a. Doing a CAT Scan and trial digs
 - b. Putting a 6" drain pipe under the Waverley access
 - c. Peter Fox doing a general condition survey of the road
 - d. Discussing the whole drainage issue at the next Ctee Meeting
- 3. Broad Way Ahead. The broad way ahead as I understood it was:
 - a. Phase One:
 - CAT Scan
 - 6 inch pipe under Waverley access road
 - Peter Fox to do a Condition Survey
 - Bickleigh Work to be done
 - b. Phase 2:
 - Soakaways
 - Work at the bottom of the hill
- **4. July 2013 Ctee Meeting**. The notes of the Jul Ctee mtg are a bit sparse, but it was agreed that we would do as much of the work as possible through Alfred Homes.

- **5. Nov 13 AGM.** Paul briefed the AGM on the Drainage scope and particularly the Alfred Homes idea and indicated that residents would be shown the quotes if they were considered good value
- 6. Dec 2013. Drawings and email:
 - a. In December 2013, Paul circulated drawings to the relevant frontagers/owners showing possible soakaway holes and asking the addressees for approval in principle
 - Plan 100 two:
 - Just upstream of Landseer
 - Between Westacre and Waverley
 - Plan 101 By Folly Cottage/Eldon
 - Plan 102 by St Mary's/Pilgrims
 - b. The email went to:
 - Julian Grant Hodge at Eldon
 - Jamie Hancox at Folly Cottage
 - Roger Nicklin at St Mary's
 - Sue Turner at pilgrims
 - Paul Presland at Landseer
 - Remi Katsande is that Westacre?
 - c. I do not have all the responses but:
 - Peter Presland at Landseer asked for indemnification against future settlement and damage caused by installation
 - Later Julian Grant Hodge at an April 2014 SHA meeting expressed similar concern
 - I did not object
 - d. Between the Jun 13 Sub Ctee and the Dec 13 email, the areas seem to have changed thus:
